Andris Slesers from Weston Solutions, Inc. will present on their IEPA assignment to determine if the New Richmond Sandstone is a viable water source for the residents of Wedron, as a long-term alternative to the shallower petroleum contaminated St. Peter Sandstone. This presentation walks through the steps taken to conduct and analyze a pump test and further determine the effect of pumping the New Richmond in the Town of Wedron.
