Mr. Stuart Dykstra

Stuart's presentation will be on the Lozandieu Hydrogeologic Investigation for tourism development on the Southwest Coast of Haiti, conducted by V3 and Northwater. He will also give us a time capsule of the progress made in exploring and developing potable water resources since V3's initial involvement in Haiti over 10 years ago.

Dr. Jeff Greenberg Professor of Geology - Wheaton College

Dr. Greenberg will present the topic of engaging undergraduate geology majors in applied research & outreach. Examples include village outreach work for water supply and sanitation in Kosovo; Wheaton's WASTE Project (experimenting with natural wastewater sanitation); and projects using geoscience to address community development issues in Tanzania, South Africa and Haiti.
